The motto of the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) is "Never Stop Learning". Marian Eberly, Ed.D., OLLI's Director, explained that OLLI is hosted by Widener University and partly funded by the Osher Foundation. For an annual fee of \$275, members, who must be over age 50, can take as many courses as they want. A committee of members select courses to be offered.

According to the OLLI website, the following are some of the courses taught this fall: Understanding the Brain, Archeology, How to Live Like a Stoic, Music of the Roaring 20's, The Creative Theatre Experience, Fun with Linguistics. There was a total of 23 offered on the Main Campus.

Marian said the courses typically meet once a week for five weeks, with each class running 70 minutes. They are usually offered during the day. Marian said members can use the facilities on the Main Campus, such as the pool and the library.
