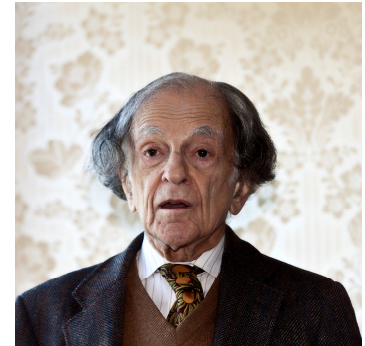

## Last Week's Speaker: Daniel Hoffman

**Daniel Hoffman**, United States Poet Laureate, 1973-1974, took us on a tour of his career sharing some of his works from along the way.

In describing Hoffman's poems, Stephen Dunn said, "In them is a lifetime of careful observance, the voice rarely raised yet passionate in its precisions, the man behind it enough a lover of life to have been properly critical of the way we've lived it." This we saw in the pieces that he read to us last week.

In addition to serving as Consultant in Poetry to the Library of Congress from 1973 to 1974 (now called the Poet Laureate) he is a Chancellor Emeritus of The Academy of American Poets. From 1988 to 1999 Hoffman was Poet in Residence at St. John the Divine.

Most recently, he received an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from Swarthmore College.
