Invitations have gone out to all Club Members and they should arrive in the coming days if you have not received yours already.

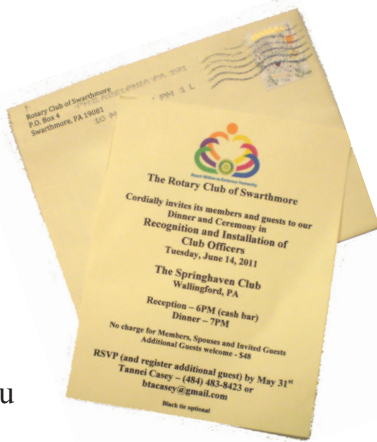
