A Message from the Water & Sanitation Rotary Action Group

Our friends at the WASH Advocacy Initiatives have asked us to pass on this message to Wasrag members and contacts located in the USA.

In the next few days the U.S. House of Representatives will bring its FY12 appropriations bill to the floor in the form of an omnibus spending package. This bill is likely to include funding for foreign assistance through the State Department and the US Agency for International Development (USAID).

As humanitarians dedicated to bringing safe water and sanitation to those in desperate need, please consider reaching out to your Representative and Senators today and relay the attached message to them by phone or fax.
