President Hillard Warren Pouncy, III told us about and showed us photographs from a book that he created about his father, Hillard Warren Pouncy, Jr., with the help of wife Carolyn and Rotarian Gudmund Iversen.

Hillard's father, now in his 90s, is a chemist who spent most of his career working for the Union Carbide Co., earning a patent in the process. A particularly dramatic and formative part of his life was serving as a bombardier-in-training with the famed Tuskegee Airmen group, the first African-American aviators to serve in the U.S. military, in WWII. Their success served their country well and opened doors permanently.

They worked tirelessly prior to and during the Fun-Fair to produce delicious sandwiches of pulled pork, chicken sausage, veggie burgers, hamburgers, cheeseburgers and hot dogs. The results were fantastic. At the end of the day, the Food Tent had raised a net amount of \$6,000 for ABC Strath Haven and Rotary.



Hillard's father shares the Congressional Gold Medal awarded to the group, the highest civilian honor bestowed by the U.S. Congress, for their successful military record "that inspired revolutionary reform in the Armed Forces." Hillard's father enjoyed visiting school children and talking at other events about the Tuskegee Airmen, and became a popular local public speaker.

Hillard's father was invited to the Inauguration of President Obama with other Airmen and was "pampered" as a Medal award winner. He has also been named a Father of the Year by the National Partnership for Community Leadership.
