

Shamyra is a senior at Chester's STEM high school, and hopes to become a doctor working in geriatrics. She spoke about her summer internship at the Chester Senior Center, where, she said, "Bingo is a sport." Her favorite part was helping people who are older than they used to be retain their independence.

Nefetaria Yates, from the Chester Workforce Development Center, described some of the other internship placements last summer: at Riddle Hospital, where four students worked together to develop an anti-smoking campaign while they also rotated through multiple departments in which the staff exposed them to different health care specialties; at Hedgerow Theater, where a recent Chester High School graduate with a passion for dance choreographed the summer production of Seussical the Musical and taught dance moves to young people in Hedgerow's summer programs; and at Chester City Hall, where the staff actively mentored their interns in more than work skills.

WorkReady Chester hopes to add opportunities for Chester youth to experience workplaces with shorter-term activities such as work shadowing or informational interviewing. Rotarians are asked to be alert to potential employers, including themselves, who might participate in any of these ways.
