5% of the world population but 25% of the world's prison population. He described a promising class he teaches at Chester prison which is made up of college students and inmates. Keith has three policy recommendations: 1) invest in high quality early childhood education; 2) address the high school drop out rate; and 3) create more work opportunities in the inner-city. Good goals but not ones I've heard discussed in any recent presidential debates.
