Swarthmore21 referendum. In case you are completely unaware of local happenings, Swarthmore21 is a referendum to grant licenses to sell liquor in Swarthmore. A vote in that regard will be held May 16.

Pat Francher and Vince Barrett discussed why this was a good idea. They said the vote will be the fourth referendum on this issue, the previous ones being in 1940, 2001, and 2011. The only one to pass was the limited approval of the Inn. Pat and Vince said they were in favor of the referendum as a way to improve the economic climate in the town center.
