Cleft palate is a birth defect that is quickly corrected in babies in the U.S. The corrective surgery is not available in third world countries such as Myanmar. In addition to impacting how one can eat and drink (try swallowing with your mouth open – hard isn't it), the condition is also a stigma. The Rotoplast team performed over a hundred surgeries and trained the local medical personnel to provide follow-up care. Swarthmore Rotary donated \$1,000 to Rotoplast after Janice spoke to us last year. After her presentation last week, we are all pleased with the outcome of our donation.
