Using various lawyerly arguments, Rick demonstrated that the Constitution doesn't allow this.

Rick's final comment underscored the importance of the topic: with states, as in relationships, if it is easy to leave, then the state or person doesn't have as much impetus to work out differences. The United States is in a period of extreme differences but we will have to work them out, even though it is not going to be easy.
