Last Meeting Summary

Claire Sawyer, Director of the Scott Arboretum, told us that the Arboretum wanted to engage the Swarthmore College students with nature. Since its founding in 1929, the focus of the Arboretum has been to educate the community. Claire said Scott now wants to engage more with the student community. They established the position of Campus Engagement Coordinator in 2017, to offer students the opportunity to involve themselves in nature. Sue MacQueen was hired as the first coordination. Some guidance was necessary for the students because, Sue told us, less than half of incoming Freshman had ever taken a walk in the woods. During Freshman orientation week, Sue led guided tours in Crum Woods. Scott also gave each Freshman a free plant for their room. As we Rotarians know from our projects worldwide, giving something to a group of people many not help them if they cannot maintain it. Sue has taken care of that problem by having a plant doctor make house calls. Sue told us about many other programs, including internships and student employees. Sue was very proud to tell us that Scott worked with the College to develop a new credit course called Plants and People.

Many of us enjoy walking on the College campus and enjoying the many plants. I'm sure the students also enjoy the campus. They are now able to enjoy the plant world even more.
