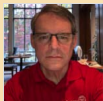

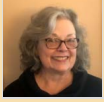

Last Meeting Summary

After a short presentation by Sarah Mahoney of the Headstrong Foundation, Club members packed personal supplies they had donated into bags to be give to patients in hospitals. Headstrong sends about 200 of the bags, called Comfort Kits, to patients across the country every week. The photos below show club members packing the bags with items such as toothpaste, tissue, and slippers.

Sarah told us that Headstrong was founded by the Colleluori family after their son, Nicholas, died of cancer. She first heard of Headstrong when she received a Comfort Kit when she was in a hospital. She started at Headstrong about five years ago.

Headstrong operates Nick’s House in Swarthmore. Nick’s House provides 2500 complimentary nights lodging annually for out-of-town patients and their families. The goal is to bring a sense of normalcy to the families.

In addition, Headstrong gives grants to patients experiencing financial hardship, provides meals to patients in hospitals, and organizes peer support groups for cancer patients.
