We have 2 grant requests.

Lucas Elliott (Eagle Scout project) has submitted a grant request for \$400 to improve the recycling center. He would like to clean and repaint the sign. He also would like to put in some new plantings. This grant is approved, subject to answering a few questions about plantings and ongoing maintenance. All voted in favor.

Lisa O'Mahoney has requested \$1,000 to assist in payment for her upcoming trip to Ethiopia with Project Cure in December. Grant money would go directly to Project Cure.

Swarthmore Rotary Charitable Trust: (Jane)

There is approximately \$59,000 in the Rotary Trust. \$16,000 is approved for grants in 2025-26.

We have dropped college student grants from our website for now, as the funding from the Women's Club has been depleted.

The Nomination Committee has recommended Earl Varney as President-Elect (PE), and he has agreed. He and Jane will talk soon.
